- 1- George called the meeting to order at 7:14pm called for proxies and made introductions.

- 14- The youth report was given by Curt Cochran explaining the recent events in the youth program. Zach Alexander, Junior Bassmaster Classic Qualifier gave a report on his experiences fishing the recent Classic event.
- 15- Information officer Wayne Crowder gave an informative update on the federation website showing a mock up of the site and explaining how it will work.
